SOME IMPORTANT PLACES

The National Archaeological Museum of Reggio Calabria

- important collection of artifacts from Magna Graecia.
- it is close to the Reggio Calabria waterfront and near Corso Garibaldi



The Riace Bronzes

- they are from 460–450 BC
- statues of two Greek soldiers
- they were found on August 16, 1972
- in the Museum since 2014





Corso Garibaldi

It is an avenue along which there are various shops, decorated during the Christmas period with lights and music.

The theatre is the most important theatre, it's very old and very big, where shows and musicals are made.







Italy Square is a big square where there are archeological remains and political palaces

Here, we have the Cathedral of Reggio Calabria. It was completed in 1928. This is the most important and the largest church in Reggio. This is an important attraction for tourists, who can find here the Madonna of Consolazione.

On the second Saturday in September, in the morning, the Madonna is trasported from the Basilica of the Hermitage to the Cathedral, and people can follow her for 3.5 kilometers. This is a special day for all the city of Reggio Calabria and around, that celebrate this day with some particular traditions.
