

- Let students generate the whole thing.
- Use "reverse" dictation as a follow-up.

- Maintain a class Quizlet.



- Photocopy word searches, crosswords and anagrams for **future** fast finishers. (Answers on the back for quick feedback.)
- Make Taboo cards for future revision lessons or progress tests.



Idea #5: Use what they know!




- Decide on a genuine final product.
- Brainstorm around topics that students know well or think about a lot.
- Agree on structure as a group.
- **Keep** the final product to use for receptive material or error correction.
- Compare with authentic examples.
